
Training session "How to understand a modern child"

On October 20, 2018 at Pedagogical Institute the 2nd round of training sessions for educators and parents "**A Lapbook of professional success**" has started.

The first training "**How to understand a modern child**" aimed at an analytical review of the basic principles of communication with children and the development of participants' skills of effective interaction with children (self-diagnostics, active listening, I-utterance, constructive ways of conflict solving).

A variety of methods and techniques, particularly interactive exercises "What did you come with", " I think we have ... in common", "The method of free associations", "Learning to formulate "I-utterance", "Punctuation reflection" contributed to the creation of an atmosphere of mutual trust to share thoughts and doubts with participants; understanding causes of difficulties in communicating with a child within the theory of generations; training in self-awareness and means of active listening ("I-utterance").

Particular interest lied in shown cartoons and videos ("Anatoliy's Pot", "How to raise children", "Jack MA on the formation of children's flexible skills") and an active reflective game "Prohibition: an adult and a child."

The professional portfolio of participants was supplemented with E-presentation on the topic and practically oriented didactic materials for effective interaction with children.
